<b>Structure:</b>	Contestant planes are divided into 3 classes: Class A - planes with wingspans of 40" and below; Class B - planes with wingspans of 65" and above 40"; Class C - planes with wingspans of greater than 65". The lowest pass (under the ribbon) is the winner in each class.		
<b>Awards:</b>	Each contestant will receive a small gift. There will be a 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> , and 3 <sup>rd</sup> place awards in each of the three classes. The ribbon will be 50 feet wide and move down one foot at a time to three feet, then moving down 6 inches at a time...
